Circuit Paul Ricard, managed by **Excelis SAS** and located in Le Castellet (France), is one of the world's most iconic motorsport venues. Since its inauguration in 1970, this racetrack has hosted 18 Formula 1 French GPs and 13 MotoGP French GPs. Today, the Circuit continues to welcome some of the world's leading motorsport events, including the Bol d'Or, GT World Challenge, etc. Renowned for its unique layout and state-of-the-art safety features, it is also a preferred venue for vehicle testing, corporate events, conferences, training programmes, photo shoots and a wide range of other activities.

As a part of this commitment, Excelis SAS has renewed the Circuit Paul Ricard's certification process in accordance with the internationally recognized **ISO 20121:2024 Standard – Event sustainability management systems**.

The ISO 20121:2024 Certification affects the internal organisation as well as the involvement of all stakeholders (employees, suppliers, organizational clients, sponsor and partners, guests and spectators, Federations, local community, private clients, media, local authorities, volunteers).

Excelis SAS has assessed and developed a series of initiatives for the Circuit Paul Ricard to strengthen its commitment to sustainable development, raising awareness among guests and users of its facilities. The certification process reflects the Circuit's determination to play an increasingly active, structured, and meaningful role in sustainability. It demonstrates our commitment to providing a venue that meets the highest standards for hosting sustainably managed events.

The **perimeter** of the ISO 20121 management system is: "**Circuit Paul Ricard**" as a "**location**" for events.

The **scope application** of the ISO 20121 management system is: "**Location of sporting, motorsporting and racing events, location of conferences, corporate and incentive events, cultural events, training courses and photo shoots at the Circuit Paul Ricard**".
