**Mission Statement ISO 20121 :2024
Circuit Paul Ricard**

Circuit Paul Ricard is a historic French racetrack located in Le Castellet, within an environmentally sensitive area of the Sainte-Baume Regional Natural Park in the South of France. Inaugurated in 1970, the Circuit has been at the forefront of technological innovation driven by a commitment to pursuing excellence and delivering unique experiences to motorsport enthusiasts and visitors alike.

Recognising the environmental, social and economic responsibilities associated with its activities, Excelis SAS has been committed for more than a decade to an ambitious sustainable development programme aimed at generating positive and lasting impacts both within the Circuit and in the surrounding area, while contributing to local socio-economic development and continuously improving its overall performance.

To support the continual improvement of Circuit Paul Ricard's sustainability performance and in alignment with its sustainability strategy, Excelis SAS has decided to implement an Event Sustainability Management System and certify the venue in accordance with the international standard **ISO 20121:2024 – Event Sustainability Management Systems**.

Excelis SAS is also committed to integrating sustainability considerations into the decision-making processes of Circuit Paul Ricard and to conducting its activities in accordance with the following principles :

- **Sustainable Development**, understood as meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

- **Responsibility and Accountability**, by identifying, assessing and managing the impacts of its activities on people, society and the environment.

- **Ethical and Transparent Governance**, ensuring integrity in the conduct of its activities and a commitment to communicating relevant information on its sustainability performance and impacts in a timely, accurate, and transparent manner.
- **Stakeholder engagement**, recognising the interests, needs expectations and concerns of relevant stakeholders and encouraging their active participation in the development and continual improvement of the Circuit's sustainability practices.

In accordance with these commitments, Excelis SAS undertakes to adopt, promote and communicate among Circuit Paul Ricard's relevant stakeholders the principles and values set out in ISO 20121:2024.

STEWARDSHIP

Pursuing responsible, transparent, and efficient management of resources, while systematically considering the environmental social and economic impacts of the Circuit Paul Ricard's activities.

This commitment is reflected throughout all phases of design, planning and delivery through the identification and assessment of environmental, social and supply chain risks and opportunities, the implementation of the Circuit Paul Ricard's Sustainable Development Policy, and the regular monitoring and evaluation of its sustainability performance.
